## How You Can Visit Our Fields

AFLC Journey Missions is the short-term trip arm of World Missions. An important part of our department, Journey Missions acts as a bridge for connecting many of our congregations in the United States with congregations on our mission fields. As the department head of Journey Missions, Jon Nelson plans trips, trains participants, and helps trip members navigate their cross-cultural experience. For almost ten years, Jon has lead these fantastic opportunities to see the work of our missionaries firsthand and serve alongside their ministry.

There are two different programs Journey Missions provides:

- Short-term ministry trips: One to Three week mission trips.
- Missionary Assistant Program: Living cross-culturally for a temporary period of time.

A few of our upcoming trips include a partnership with FLBC, taking students to Mexico, and a intergenerational Brazil trip coming this summer that is still receiving applicants.
