AFLC World Missions regularly receives requests to come and partner with mission works that are already established. Rarely do we hear from countries that have little Christian influence, as such areas can be antagonistic to the Gospel rather than inviting. It is easier to work alongside of other Christians than to go into an unreached people group.
